This course aims to equip all undergraduate students majoring in BBA with a basic background of macroeconomic concepts and basic theories in the real world and to provide policy analysis for the macro economy both in the short run and in the long run. This course covers key topics in national production, consumption, income, money, inflation, capital market, and labor market. In addition, students will understand Keynesian economic models, and in particular, the monetary and fiscal policies applied in business cycle.
