The main topics discussed include: a brief history of artificial intelligence, problem solving, representation and reasoning, knowledge-based system, a brief introduction to AI languages, and intelligent techniques and intelligent systems. Throughout this course, students are expected to further understand the important concepts of intelligent techniques, the role of intelligent system in today's IT application areas, and basic ideas of designing and developing knowledge-based systems.</p>
