Course Description

Students will learn to prepare and deliver reports. They will also learn how to evaluate literature works using a range of critical approaches to reading and writing. They will, in addition, hone their analytical thinking abilities by evaluating literary works which include a range of texts, including poems and short stories, which explore various representations in literature works, and the complex relationships within, as well as outside of texts.

The course includes intensive study of representative works from various genres and periods, concentrating on works of recognized literary merit. All of the works will be presented in English, but will come from a variety of English backgrounds.
